



Questions for Study

1. On Sunday, we heard from some of our Go Teams that served over the summer. What thoughts stuck out to you most?

One of the themes of the morning was from John 17:18. Read that verse in the context of John 17:6-19. What observations do you have about the Christian and the world?

Can you describe a time in the last year where you felt "sent" by God into the world to talk about the gospel or to demonstrate the good news by helping someone in need? Do you often feel "sent"? Why or why not?

The Great Commission in Matt 28:16-20 was also referenced. How do you think you might be connected to fulfilling that command? Do you have any ideas on how you might be more engaged in fulfilling that command?

2. If you were to do a word association as a group (each person going around and saying the first word that comes to their mind), what word would you say for "Islam"? For "Muslim"?
3. What do you know about Muslim and Islam? See how much you can collectively describe.
4. Have you gotten to know a Muslim at work, school or in your neighborhood? If so, what did you learn about them?
5. It's the 10 year anniversary of Royal Family Kids Camp at Brookside. Do you know anyone who has helped out with RFKC or TRAC? What impact has it had on their spiritual life?
6. Does something you heard about some of our global or local partners particularly stand out to you? (Daniel Project - church planting in Turkey; Tasha Hayes & Christy Taylor - helping Muslim refugees in Athens; The Shauls and Promised Land Church Planting in the Dominican Republic; The Hope Center in Zambia; Royal Family Kids Camp and TRAC Camps; Mark Thengvall - who oversees RFKC and also has other roles in his work at Mission Nebraska.)
