Week 2 | Grace and Truth Selected Scripture

Introduction

This is a three week series in response to the Supreme Court ruling that legalized same-sex marriage. As with every moral issue we face in our world today, it's imperative to know what God teaches us in scripture. Not only in regards to the issue itself, but also how we should respond as followers of Christ to those who believe differently than we do.

- Week One: We hear from Andy Stanley. Stanley gave this sermon on July 4th weekend. Through the truth of scripture he gives us the perspective we should have as we seek to live out our faith in today's culture. He points us to our responsibility and the tremendous hope that comes with it.
- Week Two: Steve looks at the biblical teaching on marriage and how we should respond to those who define it differently.
- Week Three: Ed Noble, Lead Pastor of Journey Church in La Mesa, California speaks about the power of God's grace in loving those who don't believe what we believe.

- 6. What would you say is your most pressing concern for how Brookside responds to this issue?
