### Questions for Study

4. Let's say you wrote a playbook for your life and someone asked you what you would say are the top 5 to 7 rules you've included to finish a year, a decade and lifetime well. What would those rules be?
5. Daniel had his own playbook to finish life well. Read Daniel chapters 1, 3, 5 and 6. From these chapter what rules to you find in these chapters that Daniel could have included in his playbook?
