Feb. 25-Mar. 1
Prayerful Intercession | Genesis 18:16-33

Feb. 25

Read Genesis 18:16-21

God being just, hears the outcry of oppression in Sodom and invites Abraham into his plans for the upcoming judgment. What reason did the Lord give for deciding to include Abraham in his plans? What does this tell you of his relationship with Abraham?

Feb. 26

Read 2 Chronicles 20:7-9, Isaiah 41:8

Note the word used to describe Abraham's stunning relationship with the eternal creator of the universe. Only Abraham is given this description in the Old Testament. What is this term?

Feb. 27

Read Genesis 18:22-33, Jeremiah 5:1

Abraham begins to plead as a priest – for a city, a broken, selfish, hard-hearted city. How many righteous people would it take to save the city? Was there anyone righteous enough to save the city? Why did Abraham cave at ten? In Jeremiah, how low was God willing to go?

Feb. 28

Read Jeremiah 15:1 and John 17:9-19

What other two people “stood before the Lord” as priests? Abraham's high priest role wasn't enough to save. Jesus the only righteous person, the only one who ever lived, prayed on the cross as he gave his life for those killing him – “Father Forgive them.” What else did Jesus pray as the great high priest for you in John 17:9-19?

Mar. 1

Read Hebrews 10:19-25 & Revelation 1:6

What is the calling of every believer in these verses? As you rest, savor and rejoice in the friendship, favor and sacrifice of Jesus Christ, you will grow and extend the priestly sympathy to other people.
