
You Talking to Me?

So union with God – his presence with us, in which our aloneness is banished and the meaning and full purpose of life of human existence is realized – consists chiefly in conversational relationship with God while we are engaged as his friend and co-laborer in the affairs of the Kingdom of heaven.

CREATION (Father)

19 because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them. 20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.
